Dealers: Those offering anything for sale other than Decorated Eggs are Dealers. All items for sale must relate to egg decorating. The price of a Dealer Table includes your registration. **Please Limit the "Show Specials/Clearance" To 10% of your tables.**

Tables: Each 6'x 2-½' table has a name sign. Please note: **You will need to provide your own table-cloth(s) & skirts for your table(s).** Cancellation of table space is non-refundable after May 1, 2025. Dealers/Exhibitors with 1-3 tables - no free assistant. Dealers with 4-6 tables are allowed 1 free assistant; with 7 or more tables are allowed 2 free assistants. **Electrical hookup must be requested with Registration & will be assigned 1st received, 1st assigned.**

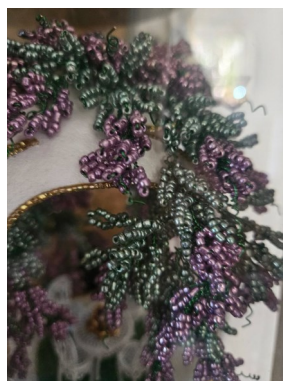
