Please note: **You will need to provide your own tablecloth(s) & skirts for your table(s).** Cancellation of table space is non-refundable after May 1, 2026. Dealers/Exhibitors with 1-3 tables - no free assistant. Dealers with 4-6 tables are allowed 1 free assistant; with 7 or more tables are allowed 2 free assistants. **Electrical hookup must be requested with Registration & will be assigned 1st received, 1st assigned.**

There are 4 fairy colors to choose from. 1. Pink with white iridescent wings. 2. Teal with teal iridescent wings. 3. Bright green with bright green wings. 4. Light blue with purple wings. No two eggs will be alike!
